### **New Initiatives in Higher Education**

The Scholar Support Programme envisions to provide continuous support to needy students of the Undergraduate courses of Government and Aided Arts and Science colleges of Kerala. The annual plan envisages extending support to scholars in the under graduate programme with timely assistance in terms of tutorials, additional lectures, interactive sessions, question banks and study materials. Students who have obtained less than 60% marks in the qualifying examination or in any subject for each semester can join for the SSP.

### **Overview**

Every year a substantial number of undergraduate students fail in the university examinations and many of them drop-out of college. Research evidence points to several reasons for low academic performance and drop-out. Systematic and consistent interventions can improve college students' academic performance and help prevent drop-outs.

Building on this idea, the Scholar Support Programme aims to identify students who are unable to perform well in examinations and understand the possible reasons behind their academic difficulties. By providing a supportive atmosphere wherein individualized and academic assistance is offered to needy students, the programme envisions **to improve exam performance** of students and **decrease drop-outs** in colleges.

### **Outcomes**

SSP has been conceptualized as a data-driven, outcome-based, feedback-oriented program. The colleges participating in the programme are expected to achieve the following outcomes at the end of each year.

1. Improvement in academic performance of low scoring students (Increase the marks in semester exams)
2. Increase in pass percentage of the identified courses(papers)
3. Decrease in the number of students who stop studies and leave college without completing the UG course (Decrease the student drop-out rate)

**The students enrolled in the programme are expected to achieve the following outcomes at the end of their tenure in the programme.**

1. Improvement in academic performance, especially in terms of examination marks
2. Increase in perceived support in college
3. Increase in self-confidence and self-esteem

The college level coordinators of Scholar Support Program are to take note that there are a few changes in the design and components of the program of the year 2019-20. The outcome assessment and the feedback from the stakeholders revealed that last year's program was effective in the components viz. **subject coaching, study skills, language training, exam writing skills and simplified notes**. The same components are retained this year as well. However, to give the maximum benefit to the targeted population, certain changes have been made in the selection process and components of the program. The program at each college has to be devised on the data related to exam results and needs of the students. In order to facilitate this purpose, SSP will be kept as an **'open door' system** in each college; its enrollment will be revised yearly, based on the data gathered

This academic year 2019-20 Dr. P C Sreenivas, Principal, Payyanur College appointed Mrs Shabna C T, Assistant Professor, Department of Mathematics, as Co-ordinator for Scholar Support Programme in the college. Co-ordinator attended two orientation camps organized by
