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#### INTRODUCTION

Payyanur College, Payyanur is a government-aided college affiliated to Kannur University. The non-partisan, non-communal, non-political Payyanur Educational Society, which was registered under the Registration of Societies Act XXI of 1860, established the college in 1965 in a vast area of about 120 acres of land which was donated/given at minimal rate by the local people who wanted to see a centre of higher learning established in their locality. Thus, starting its journey as a people's institution, the college has so far shared the fruits of higher education to around 50,000 students hailing mainly from the socio-economically backward families of North Kerala. The college is proud that it has its alumni across the globe, contributing significantly to all walks of life.

The college has been consistently recording high pass percentage with significant number of ranks in university examinations; has been winning the university Arts Festival successively; and winning university and professional games championships with impeccable track record. It has been making notable achievements in all domains through well-structured teaching-learning, research, extension, infrastructural augmentation, social orientation initiatives. The support to the weaker sections, as envisaged in its vision and mission which are based on the solid democratic foundation of inclusivity and holistic, sustainable development, has won the college much acclaim in academic and public circles.

Currently around 2000 students are pursuing their higher education in 14 UG, 5 PG and 5 PhD programmes across science, social science, humanities, commerce, and management studies disciplines. A team of 83 teachers and 30 non-teaching staff is driving the college forward, ably directed by a visionary management.

The college has always been committed to breathe in quality in all its transactions and robust policies and systems are in place for quality assurance which are piloted by the IQAC. The college was accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade in 2007 and re-accredited with 'B+' grade in 2018. This SSR is for the third cycle of accreditation. The college could secure a rank in the 151-200 rank band in the NIRF of MoE in 2024 which is a morale booster for the upcoming NAAC accreditation

### **IQAC**


#### • College Level Onam Celebrations


• Felicitation to Dr. K.V.Sujith and Alka Rajeev







## **Happiness International Film Festival Festival Touring Talkies Opening:**





### **Equal Opportunity Cell for the Differently Abled**

The Equal Opportunity Cell for the Differently Abled was constituted for ensuring an inclusive atmosphere for the disabled students on the campus. Initiating various programmes and policies, the committee tries to bring out positive changes in the life of the students who are otherwise marginalized and subjected to different forms of discrimination. The programmes undertaken by the committee in the past range from academic assistance for such children to building a more inclusive space in and around the campus. Preparing accessible study materials, formation of a scribe bank, conducting inclusive study tours and regular interactions with these students through an exclusive club called "We In Need Of Greater Space" (WINGS) etc are a few but important initiatives executed by the committee. The committee also concentrates upon providing a non-discriminatory treatment for these students on matters related to the infrastructural developments on the campus.


All the endeavours initiated and executed by the committee are motivated by the realisation that estrangement and fear are two hurdles to be overcome for a fully inclusive campus atmosphere for the disabled students. We indeed believe that some of the interventions of the committee in the past could yield results in transforming various spaces within and around the campus premises toaccommodate their needs. The below is a list of a few such events and programmes organised by the committee since its inception.

### **Examination Support**

The committee takes special care for examination related matters of the differently abled students. It supports and ensures timely submission of application for scribe and extra time for the examination and does adequate follow ups. The committee also ensures that the grace mark requests of the eligible students are submitted in time to the University with all supporting documents. NSS volunteers from the college and students from neighbouring schools serve as scribes for the eligible disabled students, and the NSS units of the college take initiative for this.


### **International Helen Keller Day (27 June 2023)**


### • Cancer Awareness Programme:

### • International Women's Day Celebration




### **Student Induction Programme**



### **Deputy Collecter's Order to Enroll Students in Voters' List:**




In line with the directive from the Higher Education Department (No. K1/169/2023/HEdn, dated 25/07/2023) and as part of the Systematic Voter's Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) Program, the Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) of Payyanur College has been actively working towards enhancing voter enrollment and awareness among students. The voter turnout among the 18-25 age group remains comparatively low, and various initiatives are in place to address this gap.

### Key activities undertaken by the ELC include:

1. **Voter Enrollment Campaign**: The ELC, in collaboration with the NSS Unit 10, conducted a survey to identify students over 18 years old who are yet to receive their voter ID cards.

- 2. **Facilitation of Online Voter Services**: To make the voter registration process accessible, the National Voters Service Portal (<a href="https://voters.eci.gov.in/">https://voters.eci.gov.in/</a>) has been linked on the official college website (<a href="https://payyanurcollege.ac.in/">https://payyanurcollege.ac.in/</a>), thus allowing students to register as voters, update voter details, and check their status on the electoral roll, streamlining the process and ensuring convenience.
- 3. **Awareness Campaign**: The ELC also conducted awareness sessions about the importance of voting, with a focus on encouraging students to participate in the upcoming elections. The students were well-informed about the electoral procedures and their role as responsible citizens.

By setting up Voter Enrolment desks and providing digital tools and awareness, the ELC is making significant moves in increasing voter participation among college students.



The Electoral Literacy Club is a forum for educating students about their electoral rights and familiarizing them with the electoral process of registration and voting. It is important to know how many of the 1984 students of Payyannur College have election ID cards / numbers.


### **Voter ID Registration Camp**






### Voter ID Registration in Payyanur College on 21 March 2024



learning on various fungal staining methods.






the undergraduate and postgraduate sections actively participated in the event. The inauguration marks a significant milestone for our association's future activities.

The session was really insightful for the students.





develop and refine the skills necessary for successful leadership and organizational growth.






to Rajat Vengupoalan Nair and Sharon Biju for securing ranks in the university examination.

# **Department of Economics**




with memories ,fun games and happiness. The celebration included all the faculties of the Economics department and final year students.










## **Department of English**




## **Department of Malayalam**


As a part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, the department organized a program titled




## **Department of Mathematics**


• Freshers' Day was arranged to officially welcome First Year students to the Department. Senior students organized the programme with variety of tasks and address by the faculty.
