




2. The feedback analysis





















From the data provided, the following inferences can be made:

General Academic Atmosphere and Teaching-Learning Quality:

The majority of respondents find the academic atmosphere positive, with 56.9% rating it as good and 34.2% as very good.

The teaching-learning process is similarly appreciated, with 90.2% rating it as good or very good.

Teacher Performance and Student-Teacher Relationship:

92.8% rate teacher performance positively (good or very good), though 0.6% rate it as poor, indicating some room for improvement.

87% of respondents rate the student-teacher relationship highly, while 1.7% report it as poor, suggesting general satisfaction but with minor issues.

Internal Assessment and Mentoring System:

While 83.9% find the internal assessment system fair, 1.4% rate it as poor, indicating a small group with concerns. The mentoring system is effective for 76.7%, but 22.5% rate it as average, poor, or very poor, showing a need for more personalized guidance.

Support for Weaker Students and Co-curricular Activities:

79.3% find support for weaker students good or very good, though 20.4% feel it needs improvement.Co-curricular activities, such as seminars and workshops, are well-regarded by 78.7%, but 4.9% feel it lacks effectiveness.

Career and Counselling Cell:

This area shows the most dissatisfaction, with 24.7% rating it as average and 7.2% as poor or very poor, signaling the need for stronger support in career counseling.

NCC/NSS Activities and Grievance Redressal:

85.9% are satisfied with NCC/NSS activities, while grievance redressal has 77% approval, though 4.3% feel it's slow or ineffective.

Infrastructure and Library Facilities:

General infrastructure facilities receive positive feedback from 79.3%, though 20.4% rate it as average or poor. The central library is highly rated by 90.8%, with the department library receiving 82.8% positive responses despite some room for improvement.

Hostel and Girls' Room Facilities:

Hostel facilities have a large non-responding group (33.7%), and only 42.5% find the facilities good, indicating a significant need for improvement. The Girls' Room also has low ratings, with 8.4% finding it very poor and only 54.9% rating it positively, suggesting dissatisfaction among female students.

Recreational and Canteen Facilities:

Recreational facilities are rated positively by 73.3%, though 23.3% find them average, indicating a potential need for more options.Canteen facilities are praised by 91.7% of respondents, showing a generally high level of satisfaction.

Sports, Cultural, and Medical Facilities:

Opportunities for sports and cultural activities receive high ratings, with 91.2% and 88.6% of students finding them satisfactory. Medical aid, however, shows mixed feedback, with 26.1% rating it as average and 7.2% rating it as poor, suggesting the need for improved health services.

Transport, Discipline, and Overall Growth:

Transport services are highly regarded by 79.8%, and discipline is rated positively by 79.6% of respondents. The college's role in students' academic and personal growth is well-rated by 81%, although 18.4% rate it as average or worse.

Overall, while the college performs well in areas like teaching quality, infrastructure, and co-curricular opportunities, there are concerns regarding mentoring, career counseling, hostel facilities, and medical aid, indicating areas for potential improvement..
